



Press Release, July 2010: ECVC Wins National Award

The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) has announced that Eastern Carolina Vocational Center, Inc. (ECVC) of Greenville NC has been selected as the DLA Outstanding AbilityOne Program Vendor of the year. Vice Admiral (VADM), Alan S. Thompson, SC, USN, Director, Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), will present this national award at a conference in Columbus, Ohio on August 25, 2010. The Defense Supply Center Columbus nominated ECVC for the award. In 2001, 2005 and 2007; ECVC also was recognized by DLA as the Outstanding AbilityOne Program Vendor of the year.

Eastern Carolina Vocational Center (ECVC) currently operates from four locations. In Greenville the corporate offices and manufacturing are located at N. Greene Street. Fine Finishes Custom Framing and metal casting are at 901 Staton Road. At MCAS Cherry Point, ECVC operates the Servmart and the Motor Transport.

ECVC is a not for profit corporation founded in 1965. One-third of the 208 people on the ECVC payroll are employed on federal government contracts with DLA, the Marine Corps and GSA. These federal contracts include the manufacture and distribution of mission critical items for the military.

The organizational mission of ECVC is to help persons with disabilities attain a higher quality of life through achievement of their vocational goals. Last year ECVC provided vocational services for 366 people with disabilities through its rehabilitation services contract with the state of North Carolina. These vocational services included the placement of seventy nine people with disabilities in jobs at companies located in the counties of Craven, Beaufort, Martin and Pitt.

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
