Highlights of their recent performances include entertaining the troops at Coast Guard Air Station Borinquen and Coast Guard Sector San Juan in Puerto Rico through the Department of Defense, Armed Forces Professional Entertainment, the 2009 VFW Convention in Phoenix, Arizona, The National World War II Museum in New Orleans, the Marine Corp Marathon in Washington, DC, Liberty Mutual PGA Tour in Savannah, Ellis Island Medal of Honor Awards on Ellis Island, DAR National Convention at Constitution Hall, Navy Day in DC, and overseas performances for the USO in Okinawa, Sasebo and Tokyo Japan, Guam and Hawaii.
