1.

Get a sticker from the City by calling 252-329-4522 or stop by Public Works located at 1500 Beatty Street off of 14th Street. Google it!



2.

Get a container...any size. A container with a lid, though, is nice to keep the recyclables dry if it happens to rain. (You can quite often find tubs with lids for as little as \$5!)



3.

Put everything recyclable into the container together (commingled). Empty bottles are nice and clean food cans are nice too!



- Plastic Bottles #1 and #2 (numbers are on the bottom)**
- Glass bottles with a neck**
- Paperboard**
- Cans—Aluminum and steel**
- Cardboard (put large boxes (broken down) by your bin)**
- Newspapers, junk mail**

4.

Place your recyclable container at the curb the same day you place your garbage can. You will not believe how little trash you have—it is amazing!
