Eastern Carolina Vocational Center located out on Staton Road in Greenville has added the following people to its staff.



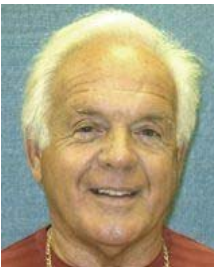
